



Ogallala Aquifer Program Research featured in the April 2009 Issue of “The Aquifer Monitor”

The Groundwater Resources Division of the Texas Development Board (TWDB) publishes a monthly newsletter, “The Aquifer Monitor”. The April 2009 issue featured a topic entitled “Center for Geospatial Technology at Texas Tech University Ready to Publicly Launch Website of Ogallala Aquifer Maps and Data”. The Center for Geospatial Technology has collected data to create maps that display changes in water in the Ogallala Aquifer between 1990 and 2004 for 41 counties in western Texas. This research was funded by ARS-USDA’s Ogallala Aquifer Program.
