An email from Dr. E. Knipling, the administrator of Agricultural Research Service (ARS), dated August 13, 2009 announced the names of three scientists to be inducted into ARS Science Hall of Fame in September. One of the three is Dr. B.A. Steward, who is currently the Director of the Dryland Agriculture Institute and Distinguished Professor at West Texas A&M University and an Ogallala Aquifer Program (OAP) cooperating scientist.
