



## SDI Field Day featured in September 2009 Issue of The Cross Section Publication

The monthly publication of the High Plains Underground Water Conservation District No. 1, The Cross Section, features photos from the Field Day on Subsurface Drip Irrigation (SDI) in August 2009 at Texas AgriLife's Helm Farm at Halfway, TX. The Ogallala Aquifer Program has provided funding for a series of educational events in 2009 and 2010 to feature research on the capabilities and best management practices of SDI. The Field Day at Halfway was the second event in 2009 with the first being a Field Day held at Colby Kansas in August. Attendance at both the Halfway and Colby Fields Days exceeded 100 people.
